

- The objective of the Water Quality Sub-Group field visit is to: identify existing gaps/bottlenecks, success stories, and recommend actions and way forward.

Research questions for the area visited (I)

Pollution of water bodies

- What are the drivers behind water pollution (including domestic waste, industrial, urban and agricultural runoff)?
- What are the effects of water pollution for the environment, people and private sector (e.g. water hyacinth, health issues and reputational risk respectively)?

Socio-economic impacts

- What are the socio-economic parameters related aspects effected by Water Quality challenges?
- What are identified socio-economic impacts, related to water use including black and grey water disposal regimes?

Research questions for the area visited (II)

Governance structures

- What are the policies and mandates related to Water Quality (at National, Basin authority, Catchment and Community level)?
- What are the administrative structures for e.g. Water Quality reporting?
- What are the standards and regulations related to Water Quality?
- What is the Capacity- (including human, financial and institutional) related to Water Quality related management?
